HKCS invites applications for of HKICT Awards 2007: Best Business Award Award scope expanded to encourage industry participation

(Hong Kong, 29 June 2007) -- The Hong Kong Computer Society (HKCS) announced that the Hong Kong ICT Awards 2007: Best Business Award (previously known as IT Excellence Awards) is now open for applications. The deadline is 23 August 2007 (Thursday) at 12:00 noon. The application form can be downloaded at www.hkcs.org.hk/ictawards.

“We have expanded the scope of the award scheme this year to encourage participation of the industry. We welcome entries for application and product awards from the following business areas, including *Financial Services, Logistics, Trading Services, Tourism Services, Retail, Learning, SME Support, Information Security, Open Source Solution and Industrial Support*”.

“Gold, silver and bronze award will be granted in each of the business areas,” said Mr Peter Yan, Chairperson of the Organizing Committee of “Hong Kong ICT Awards 2007: Best Business Award”.

The Panel of Judges is composed of well-respected industry experts and chaired by Professor Ng Ching Fai, President and Vice-Chancellor of Hong Kong Baptist University.

One of the gold award winners will be selected winner of the “Hong Kong ICT Awards 2007: Best Business Award” and nominated to compete for the ultimate accolade of the “Hong Kong ICT Award of the Year”.

Hong Kong ICT Awards were established in 2006 as a collaborative effort among industry support organizations, ICT professional bodies, academia and the government to establish a large scale and internationally recognized branding of ICT awards of Hong Kong. The award scheme is supported by the Office of the Government Chief Information Officer, the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region.

There are seven award categories and HKCS is the organizer of “Hong Kong ICT Awards 2007: Best Business Award” which has incorporated eLearning, an individual award category last year.
