Abstract

In today's wired world, Corporate Security, Law Enforcement and even personal users need a greater understanding of the possibilities and limitations of identifying other online users. How often have we seen fake banking websites, sites promoting frauds or illegal activities, malicious e-mails and general misuse of the online environment?

This hands-on workshop will show you some of the techniques and tools required to conduct effective online investigations. You will learn:

- ◆ **An understanding of how the Internet functions from an investigative perspective**
- ◆ **How to conduct effective online tracing using open source tools**
- ◆ **How to analyse web content and the http traffic**
- ◆ **Tricks and tools used to hide identities and obscure the true location of websites**

To reinforce these concepts, attendees will be given the opportunity to try different live practical exercises using the tools and techniques taught in the class.

Participants will receive a certificate of attendance from the HK Chapter of the High Technology Crime Investigation Association.

Bio of Trainer

Mr. Paul Jackson – 1st Vice President, High Technology Crime Investigation Association (HTCIA)

Paul has been working in the Hong Kong Police Force since 1988, and has been involved in technology crime related policing since 1997. Prior to joining the Force, he graduated from Liverpool University with a BEng. (Hons) degree in 'Engineering Science and Industrial Management'. He has a broad range of experience including telecommunications related investigations, computer security work, and more recently as part of the Technology Crime Division of the Commercial Crime Bureau where he has been working since 2001. He has attended numerous computer crime and forensics training programs and is the holder of two post-graduate diplomas in Computer Forensics from the HK UST.

Paul has been responsible for developing computer crime investigation training programs on behalf of the Interpol Asia South Pacific Working Party on IT Crime, and has led regional training programs in Korea, Japan and American Samoa. In addition, he has led training to Indian Police Forces in Mumbai, and has assisted with delivering IT Crime investigation training to European Police Forces on the AGIS program. He has also delivered presentations at numerous international computer crime related conferences.

After promotion in 2006 to Chief Inspector, Paul took over as head of the Forensic Section for the Technology Crime Division, in charge of two teams of digital forensic examiners as well as the HK Police's technology crime investigation training team. Outside of the HK Police Force, he is the current 1st Vice President of the High Technology Crime Investigation Association Asia Pacific Chapter and is also Vice Chairman of the International Organisation on Computer Evidence (IOCE).
