APICTA 2012 Will Take Place from December 3 to 5
HKCS Nominated 27 Outstanding Local Products to Compete in 14 Categories

December 2, 2012 Hong Kong – Hong Kong Computer Society (HKCS) nominated 27 outstanding local products, 21 of which are winners in HKICTA2012 while the other six also won in local ICT awards, to participate in the Asia Pacific Information and Communications Technology Awards 2012 (APICTA 2012) to be held in Brunei from December 3 to 5. The Hong Kong delegate will fly to Brunei today and compete in 14 award categories.

APICTA recognises outstanding contributions to information and communication technology (ICT) in the region and raises community awareness of ICT. Grand Awards go to the winners in each of the 17 categories. Certificates of Merit are also awarded in each category if an entry achieves 95 percent or more of the winning score.

All 27 participating products and applications have received recognition in various ICT related awards in Hong Kong and are nominated by HKCS. 21 of them have won in HKICTA2012, including iButterfly, developed by Cherrypicks Ltd. and Media Palette Hong Kong, and winner of **HKICTA2012 Award of the Year as well as Best Ubiquitous Networking Grand Award**; Community Health Call Centre, winner of **Best Innovation & Research Grand Award**; WeBuzz Facebook Page Application, winner of **Best Business Grand Award**. Successful entries also include iSav: A Data Security Appliance, winner of Hong Kong Award for Industries: Technological Achievement Grand Award, and others. Cherrypicks / Media Palette Hong Kong	iButterfly	HKICTA2012 Award of the Year and Best Ubiquitous Networking Grand Award	iButterfly is a gamified location-based coupon and content entertainment App platform where users acquire coupon or content by physically hunting and catching 3D flying butterflies. Making use of 3D engine, AR, location enablement and motion-sensing technologies, iButterfly combines the joy of social gaming and coupon download services together to introduce the brand new user experience.

The Hospital Authority	Community Health Call Centre	HKICTA 2012 Best Innovation & Research Grand Award;	The Hospital Authority (HA) innovated the Community Health Call Centre supporting management of targeted high risk elderly patients leveraging on a validated risk prediction model, through regression modeling on 14 clinical predictors based on patient data in our medical record system, to output a predicted probability of emergency admission within 28 days of discharge from major acute hospital among the elderly medical patients. With the help of the risk stratification, HA adopted a proactive approach in giving mainly outbound (instead of traditional inbound) calls to those high risk patients and track them to ensure their health in the community. Three independent evaluations demonstrated a 25-50% reduction of hospital utilization rates, with improvement of clinical outcomes.
WeBuzz Limited	Facebook Page Interactive Marketing Solutions	HKICTA 2012 Best Business Grand Award	WeBuzz platform is a software-as-a-service (SaaS) technology that allows marketers to customize a brand's image and engage fans on Facebook. It currently provides 23 Interactive Marketing Solutions for Facebook Page owners to help them achieve social marketing goals. Engaging solutions including Buzz Creator, Video Contest and Photo Contest facilitate interactions between the customers and the Page owners. These solutions manage to encourage fans to participate and share branded contents with their friends. Increase in fans' engagement will lead Facebook to automatically expose fans to more relevant Page contents, which in turn increases the social marketing potential of a Page. It can also be used to provide fans with incentives or timed product discounts, turning fans into potential customers. The platform helps Pages feature compelling multi-media and cutting-edge graphic designs to bring visual enjoyment to fans and impress them with a distinct brand image.

nwStor Limited	iSav Data Security Appliance	2012 Technological Achievement Grand Award of the Hong Kong Awards for Industries.	iSav Data Security Appliance is a hardware system solution which protects data stored in NAS and file servers within a company's Intranet. Serving as a final defense behind the company's firewall, iSav effectively prevents attacks from hackers and unauthorized insider access to sensitive data. Each file is encrypted with a unique AES 256-bit encryption key. No encryption keys are outside iSav. Since iSav is a network device, it is immune from hacking. Compared with software solutions, iSav has no compatibility issues with different operating systems and software applications. iSav has been proven and recognized for its effectiveness in data security by various customers.

Mr. Stephen Lau, JP, President, HKCS, noted: "HKCS has strived to promote local ICT professional development. Ever since 2001 when Hong Kong joined as a member economy of APICTA, HKCS has represented Hong Kong in its Executive Committee and taken responsibility for nominating and coordinating competing entries in Hong Kong."

Mr. Lau has great expectation of all participating products: "It was really encouraging that local organizations won the Ever-best results last year in APICTA2011 with 14 prizes in total. I eagerly wish the participating teams will continue the success and achieve even better results this year."

APICTA 2012 will be held at Empire Hotel and Country Club in Bandar Seri Begawan, Negara Brunei Darussalam, with 17 competing categories. The 27 entries from Hong Kong will compete in 14 categories, including:
