### **2013 Shanghai-Hong Kong-Taiwan Youth IT Summer Camp Kick Off Today**

**Theme: “Environmental Protection with IT Green Technology”**

**July 31st 2013 • Hong Kong** — The Shanghai-Hong Kong-Taiwan Youth IT Summer Camp 2013, co-organised by Hong Kong Computer Society (HKCS), Shanghai Computer Society and Information Management Association, Taiwan, and jointly sponsored by PCCW and HKT, holds its opening ceremony to kick off the five-day event in Hong Kong today. The theme of this year is “Environmental Protection with IT Green Technology (綠色科技創未來 · 培養 IT 新人才)”, with an objective to encourage youngsters from the three cities to apply the latest IT green technology in day-to-day and protect the environment.

A total of 60 outstanding students, with 20 of them selected from Hong Kong, Shanghai and Taiwan respectively, join the IT Summer Camp this year. The opening ceremony is held in The Chinese University of Hong Kong this afternoon. Mr. Richard LI, Chairman and Chief Executive of Pacific Century Group attended as Guest of Honour. Mr. TONG, Xiao Kang, Vice Secretary-General of Shanghai Computer Society, Mr. Andrew WANG, President of Information Management Association (Taiwan), Mr. Michael LEUNG, President of Hong Kong Computer Society are invited as the officiating guests to witness the great moment when, the first time, those IT young elites of Shanghai, Hong Kong and Taiwan jointly strive for caring the environment with information technology.

“This year is the first time we have Taiwan youngsters to join us. As the IT development of Taiwan has been standing at a certain high level in Asia, I believe all the participants will uplift their vision and knowledge during the exchange. I hope these IT young talents from Shanghai, Hong Kong and Taiwan would learn from observation and practice through this cross-border experiential exchange program, with the support and encouragement from each other. What’s more, they are highly encouraged to build a harmonious society by serving the community with united power and IT knowledge.” Said Mr. Michael Leung, President of Hong Kong Computer Society.

Mr. Ted SUEN, Chairperson of Organising Committee of IT Summer Camp 2013 stated during his speech that The IT Camp this year incorporated numerous activities. Participants will visit to various large scale IT institutes and facilities such as Science Park, Airport Authority, E&M Department of Hong Kong SAR Government, PCCW Tower, CyberPort and so on.
