Hong Kong Computer Society Elected New Council Members

*Continue to Strive for Council Development through its Five Core Values
Taking Professional Development, Young IT Talent Cultivation
and Society Caring Through IT as Priorities*

June 15, 2018, Hong Kong – The new Council members of the Hong Kong Computer Society (HKCS), the largest Information and Communication Technology (ICT) professional body in Hong Kong, have been elected in the Annual General Meeting on 3 May 2018. To lead the Hong Kong Computer Society to a new milestone, the Council will continue to uphold its five core values, including Professional Development, Career Advancement, Job Assistance, Industry Collaboration and Community Engagement. These values aim to foster the further development of HKCS, and assist the Hong Kong ICT industry to enhance its competitiveness in the international arena, and thus contribute to the long-term development of the Hong Kong economy. HKCS also strives to encourage students to pursue IT-related studies at the tertiary institutions.

Ir. Ted Suen, President of the Hong Kong Computer Society said: "Being the most well-established and the largest professional association in Hong Kong, we are constantly evolving to meet the latest developments in the technology industry. During the year, the Society has consolidated its seven Special Interest Groups into four Specialist Groups – Artificial Intelligence, Financial Technology, Cyber Security and Enterprise Architecture – to reflect emergent ICT technologies that have the most impact on Hong Kong's future industry development. Meanwhile, we have launched the IT Leadership Accelerator Platform (iLEAP) to equip senior IT practitioners with the crucial skills for navigating challenges in the new technological landscape and prepare themselves for more senior leadership roles, which in turn, nurture more elite leaders to support Hong Kong's economic development through ICT innovation."

Ir. Ted Suen pointed out that, a truly digital innovation requires IT professionals who can be fully devoted, understand the latest technology, have innovative talents, and can lead changes. HKCS will continue to focus on talent cultivation, promote professional development of the industry, and encourage more youths to pursue IT-related studies and to take up ICT as their careers.

Ir. Ted Suen remarked: "On behalf of the HKCS, I would like to thank the members of the previous Council, the Special Interest Groups and the revamped four Specialist Groups, as well as the Committees, the FACE Club, the Innovation and Entrepreneurship Club and the Youth Club for their contributions. We also welcome the new members to this session. Their joining brings the Council with an even broader spectrum of industry's distinguished talents, which enables us to strive for the development of the ICT industry in Hong Kong. In addition to professional development and talent cultivation, HKCS will also step into the community in the future to promote caring for the society through ICT. We hope to consolidate wider efforts of our industry, in order to encourage and assist the community in enhancing the digital operations, through our profound technology expertise and experience."
