#### e-Crime, Fraud and Security

Cyber criminals leave trails in our digitised communication networks and information systems which are useful for investigation and legal proceedings. However, law enforcement agencies, IT professionals and the legal community face tremendous challenge when it comes to identify culprits and collect and preserve digital evidence for prosecution. The panelists will share their knowledge and experience about current cybercrime trends and statistics, contemporary cybercrime laws, corporate policies and strategies to manage the risks of cyber abuses, new IT security initiatives, use of digital forensics tools, and e-discovery teams and incident response.
