- 5) Elections shall be conducted on the basis of a simple majority vote of Distinguished Fellows, Fellows and Full members present, in person or by proxy, at the AGM.
- 6) Candidature for President / Council Members shall be proposed and seconded at the Annual General Meeting. No proposal will be accepted without the consent of the nominee. Subject to minimum qualification votes equivalent to one half of the total number of eligible votes for the election, candidate who receives the highest number of votes shall be offered the subject position.
