**Hong Kong Computer Society Call for Entries for
“Hong Kong ICT Awards 2013: Best Business Award”**

December 19, 2012 • Hong Kong – “Hong Kong ICT Award 2013: Best Business Award”, the recognition of ICT business application achievements, organised by Hong Kong Computer Society, is open for entries now. The closing date for entries will be January 11, 2013. There are three award categories: Best Business (Application) Award, Best Business (Product) Award and Best Business (Start-up Company) Award.

Gold, silver and bronze awards will be presented in three award streams respectively. One of the gold award winners among the three streams will be selected as the winner of the “Hong Kong ICT Awards 2013: Best Business Grand Award” and be nominated to compete for the ultimate accolade of “Award of the Year” of “Hong Kong ICT Awards

The Chairperson of judging panel is Prof. John Chi-yan Leong, SBS, JP, President of The Open University of Hong Kong. The members of judging panel include Mrs. Agnes Mak Tang Pik-Yee, MH, JP, Executive Director of Hong Kong Productivity Council, Ir. Dr. Ng Chak-Man, Chairman of The Hong Kong Institution of Engineers – Information Technology Division, Mr. E. Anthony Tan, Chief Executive Officer of Hong Kong Science & Technology Parks Corporation, Mr. Andy Bien, Chief Information Officer of Airport Authority Hong Kong, Mr. Ted Suen, Head of Information Technology of MTR Corporation, Mr. Raymond Yip, Assistant Executive Director of Hong Kong Trade Development Council and Prof. Yue On-Ching, Science Advisor of Innovation and Technology Commission, The Government of the HKSAR.

Mr. Stephen Lau, JP, President, Hong Kong Computer Society noted that the “Hong Kong ICT Awards 2013: Best Business Award” aimed to promote greater use of ICT in the community, in turn helping to create a culture of ICT usage in business as well as in daily life and to encourage original software development and promote improved creativity in the exploitation of technology in the local ICT industry. Mr. Stephen Lau pointed out that as the winners of Hong Kong ICT Awards, their achievements will be made aware by customers, organizations, the ICT industry practitioners and the entire community. The logo projects the reputation of the Awards in the ICT industry. It also represents that the ICT industry is raising their professionalism towards international recognition. All the winners of Hong Kong ICT Award will be selectively considered for nomination to participate in the Asia Pacific Information and Communications Technology Awards (APICTA). This year, Hong Kong delegates achieved a good result in APICTA2012 with a total of 12 prizes, including 5 Grand Awards and 7 Merits, which most of them are Hong Kong ICT Award winners.

Mr. Stephen Lau further pointed out that Hong Kong will host APICTA2013 next year and urged the local ICT elites could spare no efforts in proposing outstanding products to compete with entries from other districts and win the glory for Hong Kong. “It is a prerequisite of participating in this Asia Pacific event that their entries must achieve local ICT relevant award before. Thus, HKCS encourages local ICT talents to actively join the ‘Hong Kong ICT Award 2013: Best Business Award’ and endeavor to win the prizes.” Added Mr. Stephen Lau.
