Hong Kong International Computer Conference 2013 Kicks Off Today
Themed by Technology Disruptions Transform Business
With The Golden Jubilee of HK's First Computer Photo Exhibition held on Nov 27
APICTA2013 Concurrently Takes Place in HK

November 26, 2013 • Hong Kong — Hong Kong International Computer Conference 2013 (HKICC2013), organised by Hong Kong Computer Society (HKCS) kicks off today at Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Center. With the theme of “Technology Disruptions Transform Business”, the two-day conference aims to deliberate how Information and Communication Technology (ICT) has and will continue to facilitate business changes and economic development in Hong Kong.

HKICC2013 Opening Ceremony will be officiated by Mr. Gregory So Kam-leung, JP, Secretary for Commerce and Economic Development, The Government of the HKSAR. Mr. Gregory So, together with Mr. Michael Leung, President of Hong Kong Computer Society and Chairperson of HKICC2013 Organising Committee, and Mr. Sunny Lee, JP, Chairperson of HKICC2013 Programme Committee, will jointly host the ceremony.

Mr. Michael Leung stressed in his speech: “HKICC2013 will continue its effort to explore more ICT possibilities with collective power from the industry. For the past decades, disruptive technology has fundamentally changed many traditional business models. The most successful enterprises have been those who excel in reaping the full benefits of product and service innovations. Quite aptly, the conference theme of this year is Technology Disruptions Transform Business. We hope more constructive ideas will be shared to promote business and economic developments.”

Mr. Sunny Lee noted that the conference has invited world-class speakers to share their unique insights. Speakers include CEOs and CIOs from established international corporations, senior government officials from both the Mainland and Hong Kong, academics from famous local and overseas institutions and so on.

Mr. Sunny Lee introduced the conference programme: “the topics are selected to reveal the latest ICT development and trends, and discern future directions. The conference covers five major areas, including **Big Data Transform Business, Mobility, Social Media, Mainland China Perspective** and **Business Alignment and Value Creation**, all drawing tremendous attention from the ICT and business world.” For programme details and speakers list, please refer to the attachment.

The Golden Jubilee of HK's First Computer Exhibition

Talking about the great advancement and impact of ICT nowadays, Mr. Michael Leung specifically mentioned 2013 was the golden jubilee of Hong Kong's first computer. In 1963, CLP Power Hong Kong Limited (CLP) installed the city's first top-line NCR computer, marking the beginning of the computer era in Hong Kong.

In 1964, an IBM 1620 data processing systems was installed in the Department of Civil Engineering at The University of Hong Kong.

To commemorate the important milestone, HKICC2013 will hold the Golden Jubilee of HK's First Computer Exhibition at the Convention Foyer, displaying a couple of precious photos provided by CLP and HKU. The exhibition will open from 2:00 pm to 10:00 pm.

APICTA2013 Concurrently Takes Place in HK

Concurrently, the Asia Pacific Information & Communication Technology Alliance Awards 2013 (APICTA2013), the other regional ICT flagship event hosted by Hong Kong this year, is held at Cyberport from November 24 to 26. This year, 40 award-winning local ICT entries, nominated by HKCS, will contest against strong opponents from other 17 economies for grand awards in 17 categories. As Mr. Michael Leung explained, there will be some interactions between the two remarkable events to further promote ICT exchange among the region. All contestants of APICTA 2013 are invited to join HKICC2013 program on Nov 27, while HKICC2013 delegates are welcome to attend sharing/showcasing seminars held by APICTA2013 same day at HKCEC.

The HKCS Gala Dinner cum APICTA2013 Award Presentation Ceremony will take place on November 27. All APICTA2013 contestants and HKICC2013 delegates are welcome to join and share the glory and joy of ICT award winners in the Asia Pacific region. Mr. C.Y. Leung, The Chief Executive of Hong Kong SAR, will be the officiating guest of the award ceremony.
