The content of the letter is as following:

Dear Hon. Chairman & Members of Legco,

On behalf of the Hong Kong Computer Society (HKCS), I am writing to appeal for the support of your good self and members of your Council to the Government's proposal of establishing a Technology Bureau.

We believe this proposal, which has since received broad endorsements from local industries and the community at large, would create a much needed official body that can serve to formulate strategy, devise plans and coordinate activities on all matters related to innovation and technology, and must therefore be taken outside of party politics for the benefit of Hong Kong as a whole.

As you may recall, when the subject matter was first debated at the Legco a few years ago, HKCS had on several occasions expressed our opinion in favour of setting up the Technology Bureau. We strongly believe that such Bureau will be instrumental to the long-term development of Hong Kong's commerce and industry, and its role as a special administrative region within the greater China economy.

As the most recognised association in the ICT industry in Hong Kong, HKCS urge that the Legco likewise endorse the proposal and, more importantly, take all necessary steps to help expedite the process towards the formation of the Bureau.
