#### MoDev Hong Kong 2014 Kicks off Today

Deciphering the evolving trends and applications of mobile computing

**12 April, 2014, Hong Kong** --- Co-organised by the Hong Kong Computer Society (HKCS), MoDevNetworks LLC and Hong Kong Cyberport Management Company Limited, the "MoDev Hong Kong 2014" kicked off with an opening ceremony at Cyberport this morning. A seminal international events in mobile communications, it is also one of the major events of the International IT Fest 2014. The forum featured mobile communications experts from the United States, China and Hong Kong as guest speakers, who shared their insights on the best practices for mobile applications development, deployment and marketing across the corporate and consumer markets.

The "MoDev Hong Kong 2014" Opening Ceremony was officiated by Mr. Daniel Lai, BBS, JP, Government Chief Information Officer, Office of the Government Chief Information Officer, The Government of the HKSAR, together with Mr. Michael Leung, President of Hong Kong Computer Society and Mr. Herman Lam, CEO of Hong Kong Cyberport Management Company Limited.

Mr. Michael Leung, HKCS President, remarked, "With the globally connected world, with Cloud, big data, consumerism, social media, mobility is the common driver for both business and consumer innnovative applications. With a delegation from the US, the Modev Forum in 2013 last year composed of a discussion forum in the morning with experts from US and HK in mobility to talk about the status of mobility apps in US and HK, followed in the afternoon by a fun filled activity called Disruptathon, where Apps development presented in 3 minutes each their favourite apps they developed and the audience voted thru an online app for the best presentations in areas of innovation, creativity, likely popularity and best commercial value. The event was very well received and appreciated by the community."

In addition to several talks on the present and future of the development of mobile applications by experts in mobile applications in "MoDev Hong Kong 2014", the Disruptathon was held. Also the Hong Kong International Hackathon 2014 will be held tomorrow (13 April). All these encouraged young developers, designers and entrepreneurs to collaborate and develop practical mobile applications with tremendous creativity, while serving as a platform for investors to look for business opportunities or talents in information technology.

The participants in Disruptathon devised innovative marketing concepts for different industries with mobile communications and presented their latest inventions to the audience. With the use of mobile communications, the audience provided feedback and ratings on the most disruptive entries and picked the winners.

There are three key concepts in the Disruptathon events: disruptive innovation, fast pace and interaction of all attendees. All presentations revolve around the concept of disruptive innovation. The presenters give quick presentations on their innovative ideas, and how companies, technologies and methodologies disrupt the current market. The audience provide feedback and ratings on the most disruptive entries and pick the

winners, as the process prompts close interaction between those on stage and off stage.

Mr. Leung noted, "This year 2014, our three Co-organisers expanded the Modev 1 day event in both scope and coverage, to a 5 day event, with 2 days in Shanghai and 3 days in Hong Kong. Winning teams from US, Mainland and HK Hackathons are invited to participate in visits and Modev Forum in Shanghai, then moved to HK for the MoDev Forum and Disruptaton today. The additional highlight is there is tomorrow's "Hong Kong International Hackathon 2014" where the winning teams from US, Mainland and HK will compete for three awards, The Best Creativity Award, The Best Potential Commercial Value Award, The Highest Degree of Completion Award. Post International Activities include all the teams are invited to a Sharing Session in the HKICT Expo and the three winning teams will be recognized at the HKICT Expo Cocktail Reception on Monday"

To be held on 13 April, the Hong Kong International Hackathon 2014 is a by-invitation-only contest. The word "hackathon" combines the word "hack", meaning the design of problem-solving and creative applications rather than unwelcome intrusion or illegal theft of confidential documents, with the word "marathon". During the event, programmers and their teams of software developers will collaborate intensively to develop applications. In the designated time frame, the developers will design practical applications and demonstrate their results.

Mr. Leung stated, "On behalf of HKCS I wish to thank our Co-organisers, Hong Kong Cyberport Management Company Limited and ModevNetworks LLC, for their partnership and efforts, and to MTR Corporation Limited as our event sponsor, and Microsoft Hong Kong Limited and Huawei Technologies Limited as our technology sponsors, and Pulse MediaTech Limited as our prize sponsor, Their support and CSR contribute to the success of this ambitious endeavour which require substantial resource and logisitics support."
