**Hong Kong Computer Society Elected New Council Members**

*Continue to Strive for Council Development through its Commitment to Professional Development, Young IT Talent Cultivation and Society Caring Through ICT as Priorities*

**June 8, 2022, Hong Kong** – The new Council members of the Hong Kong Computer Society (HKCS), the largest Information and Communication Technology (ICT) professional body in Hong Kong, have been elected in the Annual General Meeting on 6 June 2022. To lead HKCS to a new milestone, Dr. Rocky Cheng, President of HKCS and Council members will continue to its commitment to professional and industry development as well as community services with three main goals, namely talent cultivation and professional development; industry development and collaboration, and the effective use of IT in our community. These commitments aim to foster the further development of HKCS, and assist the Hong Kong ICT industry to enhance its competitiveness in the international arena, and thus contribute to the long-term development of the Hong Kong economy.

Dr. Rocky Cheng, President of the HKCS said: “HKCS is constantly evolving to meet the latest developments in the technology industry. In light of the current COVID-19 pandemic in every corner of the world, Hong Kong has experienced an economic downturn and has yet to see the light at the end of the tunnel. In this midst of this difficult time, HKCS encourages Hong Kong businesses and people to fully utilise ICT to their advantage. Despite the pandemic, our five Specialist Groups – Artificial Intelligence, Financial Technology, Cyber Security, Enterprise Architecture and Innovation and Entrepreneurship have continued to engage our members and the public by organising a series of offline and online events including Webinars, Luncheons, Workshops and Forums in order to build a stronger tie with our members, effectively reflect the interests of them and evolving trends in the IT industry. Professional and industry experts were invited to share their insights and knowledge with our members in a new format under the ‘New Normal’.”

Dr. Cheng pointed out that the HKSAR Government has launched the policies of driving economic growth through innovation and technology (I&T) development and Hong Kong has been positioned as an international I&T hub in Greater Bay Area. HKCS will continue to actively play the role of an "ICT Think Tank" of the Hong Kong SAR Government by providing well-informed advice and suggestions. HKCS

will also step up its efforts in promoting continuous professional development for the industry, driving the industry's professional advancement and strengthening cooperation between industry partners and government agencies, while urging the government to support the growth of the I&T industry. By building a smart city and using innovative technologies to improve people's livelihood and drive economic development, HKCS can help strengthen Hong Kong's position as an international I&T hub in the Greater Bay Area under the National 14<sup>th</sup> Five-Year Plan.

Dr. Cheng furthered: "In the future, the HKCS will continue to devote more efforts toward talent cultivation, such as introducing more recognised international professional certifications to promote the professional development of the industry, and providing I&T people a better understanding of the industry's prospects. HKCS will also try to attract more young people to join the I&T industry, for example, by encouraging more uptake of IT courses and cultivating soft power for their personal development. At the same time, HKCS will also urge the government to provide young people in Hong Kong with a good ecology for employment and entrepreneurship, so as to help them realise the dream of changing the world with technology and creating a better future. Besides, HKCS will assist members in tapping more development opportunities in Greater Bay Area by strengthening communications with its cooperation partners in the Area."

Dr. Cheng remarked: "On behalf of the HKCS, I would like to thank the members of the previous Council, the five Specialist Groups, CIO Board, iLEAP, FACE Club as well as all Committees for their support and contributions. We also welcome the new members to this session. Their joining brings the Council with an even broader spectrum of industry's distinguished talents, which enables us to strive for the development of the ICT industry in Hong Kong. In addition to professional development and talent cultivation, HKCS will also step into the community in the future to promote caring for the society through ICT. We hope to consolidate wider efforts of our industry, in order to encourage and assist the community in enhancing the digital operations, through our profound technology expertise and experience."
