Hong Kong Computer Society Elects New Council Members

Mr. Dave Chen Elected as New President

Empowering the Next Generation, Advancing Innovation & Technology as a Key
Driver of Hong Kong's Economic Growth

16 July 2025, Hong Kong – The Hong Kong Computer Society (HKCS) successfully elected its new Council for the 2025-2026 term at its Annual General Meeting held on 27 June 2025. Mr. Dave Chen was elected as President and will lead the newly formed Council in driving the Society's mission to enhance professional services for members, nurture young IT talents, promote the development of Hong Kong's Innovation & Technology (I&T) industry and deepen community engagement.

Mr. Dave Chen, President of the HKCS stated: “Last year, HKCS led the IT community with a strong emphasis on Cybersecurity and Artificial Intelligence (AI) — key enablers of digital transformation and future growth. We have continued to strengthen member and public engagement by organising a series of physical and online events including seminars, conferences, forums, executive luncheons, company visits, exchange tours and webinars. These platforms allow us to foster closer connections with our members while addressing industry trends and concerns. We are honoured to have welcomed numerous professionals and industry leaders to share their expertise throughout the year.”

Mr. Chen also emphasised HKCS's active role in supporting technology policies and participating in social affairs: “HKCS regularly offers professional insights on major tech issues and submit recommendations to the Government, particularly in response to the Budget and Policy Address. Many of these proposals have been adopted, reinforcing HKCS's role as a trusted ‘I&T think tank’. Looking ahead, we will continue to provide policy advice, advocate for continuous professional development, enhance industry standards, and promote greater collaboration between Government and industry stakeholders.”

Mr. Chen continued: “During the year, HKCS made significant strides in positioning Hong Kong as an international I&T hub. HKCS was once again appointed by the Digital Policy Office (DPO) as the Leading Organiser of ‘The Hong Kong ICT Awards 2024: Smart Business Award’, with the appointment reaching its 18th consecutive year. HKCS selected, invited, nominated, coached and led 25 local ICT Awards winning teams from local organisations, universities and schools competing in Asia Pacific Information and Communication Technology Alliance Awards 2024 (APICTA 2024) in Brunei Darussalam. Hong Kong delegates won a total of 8 Grand Winners Awards, 4 First Runner Up Awards, 3 Second Runner Up Awards and 3 Merits Awards this year. Hong Kong has consistently been the economy with the most winner awards in recent years, further affirming the Hong Kong’s leadership in I&T across the Asia-Pacific region.”

Mr. Chen also highlighted HKCS’s ongoing commitment to talent development: “Our flagship programme, iLEAP (IT Leadership Accelerator Platform), is now welcoming its seventh cohort. Since inception, iLEAP has graduated 82 professionals across its first four cohorts, many of whom have taken on key leadership roles in the industry. This year, 17 members of the fifth cohort also completed the programme successfully. Beyond iLEAP, we are committed to elevate the professional standards of our industry. We will also continue to inspire youth to pursue IT careers by promoting IT education, cultivating soft skills, and urging the Government to create a favourable environment for youth employment and entrepreneurship. Additionally, HKCS will strengthen ties with partners in the Greater Bay Area to unlock more cross-border development opportunities for our members.

Mr. Chen concluded: "HKCS celebrates its 55th anniversary this year and our recent relocation to our own dedicated office marks a new chapter in our journey. I would like to express my sincere appreciation to previous Council members, in particular, to our immediate past president, Dr. Rocky Cheng, JP, as well as the CIO Board, Specialist Groups, Industry Groups, iLEAP, FACE Club as well as all Committees for their support and contributions. I also warmly welcome our newly elected Council members. Their diverse expertise and passion will further empower HKCS to drive I&T development in Hong Kong. Moving forward, we will also broaden our community outreach to promote social responsibility, helping organisations and individuals enhance their digital readiness and capabilities through our collective knowledge and experience.
