

Hong Kong Computer Society Announces the Consolidation of Seven Special Interest Groups into Four Specialist Groups

30 January 2018, Hong Kong – The Hong Kong Computer Society (HKCS) announced that it will consolidate its seven Special Interest Groups (SIG) into four Specialist Groups (SG) to reflect the interests of its members and evolving trends in the IT industry. The four new SGs are Artificial Intelligence, Financial Technology, Cyber Security and Enterprise Architecture.

Ir. Ted Suen, President of HKCS explained, "As a premier professional body for the IT sector in Hong Kong, the primary objective of HKCS is to promote information technology by providing a medium for the sharing of knowledge and promoting the appreciation of emerging technologies to benefit its members. One of the key pillars of HKCS is its Specialist Groups (SGs), which conduct various professional development activities for HKCS members as well as for the IT community at large. We have recently consolidated our SGs from seven to four, as they more accurately reflect our members' key areas of focus and emerging IT trends."
