Hong Kong Computer Society Announces a Positive Results of ICT Industry Employment and Salary Trend Survey.

54.88% of ICT Professionals will enjoy a Pay Rise this year and 25% among them will witness an average growth rate of 4% or above

In 2024: ICT Professionals in 69.51% Companies Enjoyed a Pay Rise;

46.3% Companies Increased ICT headcount;

Nearly 68% ICT Graduates Earned more than \$18K

May 18, 2025 · Hong Kong — Hong Kong Computer Society (HKCS) today announces positive results of Hong Kong ICT Industry Employment and Salary Trend Survey. 54.88% of surveyed companies will raise the salary of ICT Professionals this year, of which 26.92% of the respondents will have an average growth rate of 4% or more. Besides, in the year of 2024, 69.51% of ICT professionals received a pay rise while 30.3% of the companies offered a raise at 4% or above, outperforming the inflation rate of 1.1% stated in Budget 2025. Facing uncertain economic prospects, based on the survey findings, 82.93% of respondents did not layoff ICT staff. Instead, 46.34% of the respondents confirmed an increase in headcount, reflecting a satisfactory career prospect in the ICT industry.

Moreover, 50% of the respondents hired ICT fresh graduates in 2024, with 68% of them offering a starting monthly salary over HK\$18,000, while over 30% of them offering higher than HK\$22,000 per month. 28.57% of companies offered a raise at over 4%, indicating a good prospect for ICT graduates.

Dr. Rocky Cheng, President of the Hong Kong Computer Society, remarked, "The ICT industry continues to face a significant talent shortage. While nearly 70% of companies increased ICT personnel salaries in 2024, this year the figure is expected to be 54.88%. Notably, many companies plan salary adjustments that will outpace inflation, demonstrating that over half of ICT professionals can still anticipate real wage growth."

Dr. Cheng further pointed out, "The country's 14th Five-Year Plan has long established Hong Kong as an international Innovation and Technology (I&T) Hub. Despite ongoing uncertainties in the global landscape and economic outlook, the Hong Kong Government of SAR remains committed to investing significant resources in advancing the innovation and technology sector. Beyond leveraging innovation to drive local economic growth, the government is prioritising the development of artificial intelligence to foster 'new quality productive forces.' This strategic focus encompasses major infrastructure initiatives such as the Northern Metropolis and the Shenzhen-Hong Kong Science and Technology Innovation Cooperation Zone, the enhancement of eGovernment services, and the facilitation of digital transformation across diverse industries. Moreover, there is an intensive effort to attract multinational technology firms and startups to Hong Kong, promoting deeper integration and collaboration between Hong Kong and the Greater Bay Area's I&T ecosystems. This synergy is set to generate expanded career opportunities for ICT professionals in the city. Accordingly, I encourage young people to pursue careers in the ICT sector and to select relevant academic disciplines at university. Simultaneously, the Government must actively cultivate talent not only in traditional ICT fields but also in cutting-edge areas such as artificial intelligence, Fintech, cybersecurity, and emerging technologies, to meet the demands of long-term sustainable development."

HKCS started the questionnaire survey among corporate members in the first quarter this year and collected 83 responses including large public and private organisations. Over 79.21% of interviewed companies are hiring more than 100 employees, in which over 60% are hiring over 400 staff. Among the responses, 51.51% of them have over 100 ICT related staff. HKCS believes that the results are highly representative.

Based on the survey findings, 54.88% of ICT employees will enjoy a salary rise this year. The average growth will over 4% for 26.92% of companies.

Reviewing the Year of 2024, nearly 70% of ICT employees enjoyed a salary rise. The average growth was over 4% for over 30% of companies. 63.64% of interviewed companies offered an increase rate at 1-3%, and 3.03% even for over 10% of them.

Among the surveyed companies, over half of them hired fresh ICT graduates in 2024. 68% of hiring companies offered a starting salary higher than HK\$18,000, while 30% of them offered over HK\$22,000 to attract new talents.

As a whole, the survey also revealed that the starting salary of ICT staff was increasing. 56.86% of companies increased their starting salary for fresh graduates, while 28.57% of them offer over 4% in compare with previous year.

Dr. Cheng said, "in order to reflect that ICT is an ideal career for youngsters, HKCS collected data for the salary growth after working in the industry for 3 years and 5 years in the survey. The results showed that over 40% of ICT professionals would enjoy a salary rise of over 10% for working in the field for 3 years, while 46.31% of ICT professionals would get over 20% of salary growth after 5 years working, and 14.63% even for over 50% of them. It reflects that the salary growth of the industry has been quite ideal."

Dr. Cheng pointed out: "Despite 17.07% of companies cut ICT headcount, there was no massive layoff in the industry after the epidemic in 2024. Instead, 46.34% of the respondents confirmed an increase in headcount, of which 24.49% of the respondents had over 10% increased. Apart from that, 36.59% of the respondents froze their headcount."

Dr. Cheng elaborated, "Survey results reveal that both ICT fresh graduates and

experienced ICT professionals received salary increases in 2024, with this positive trend

expected to continue into this year, which is quite good considering current labor market

in Hong Kong. Additionally, over half of the respondents reported hiring ICT fresh

graduates last year, and 59.76% of companies plan to offer internship positions to ICT

undergraduates this year. Despite the uncertain global economic outlook, demand for

ICT talent remains robust, with companies willing to allocate greater resources to this sector. This underscores the promising growth potential within the ICT industry."
